



OFFICIAL FUT 7 REGULATIONS

validity 2019

ARTICLE 1 The present ordinance is regulatory of chapter nine of the Social Statute of the Mexican Federation of Football Association, A.C.,

A. APPLICATION OF THE REGULATION

ARTICLE 2 The provisions of this Regulation are mandatory for all participating entities and governs in general terms for the competences organized by the Amateur Sectors.

ARTICLE 3 The Amateur Sectors will formulate the specific modalities of the official or friendly competitions that they organize during the Season, which will be approved by the Organizing Committee of SPORTI, prior to the start of each Official Season.

ARTICLE 4 The Official Season of the Amateur Sector will include the period indicated by the Organizing Committee of SPORTI.

ARTICLE 5 The Amateur Sector Divisions shall endeavor to start and end the Season on the same date and at the same time, except in cases where there are differences derived from the number of TEAMS participating in each one of them.

ARTICLE 6 The Organizing Committee of SPORTI may suspend all or part of the Season in the national territory and / or extend it in case of circumstances beyond one's control, catastrophe or national emergency, by itself or at the request of the Sector concerned.

B. FIELDS The official matches of the Amateur Sector shall be played on the Fields that meet the requirements and characteristics set forth in the Laws of the Game promulgated by the International Football Association Board (IFAB).

ARTICLE 7 The Fields in which the official parties of the Amateur Sector are held must be duly in playing conditions, prior approval of their technical conditions

ARTICLE 8 The Fields where the tournaments are held shall meet the requirements referred to by the rules and specifications for official matches of the competitions organized by SPORTI, contained in Appendix II of the Affiliation Regulation, Name and Venue, according to the category where it is located, according to the Division in which it participates. With regard to various modalities of Football, Children's Football and Youth Soccer, the provisions of the FIFA Laws of the Game shall apply. On the dates that include the calendars for the celebration of the official competitions of character of the Amateur Sector, SPORTI has full jurisdiction over the field and / or playgrounds and therefore on such dates only the previously scheduled events may be held.



The approval of the games calendar automatically obliges the Teams to strictly respect the previous provision, except fortuitous events or circumstances beyond one's control.

ARTICLE 9 For the purposes of this Regulation, the following definitions shall apply:

(i) court: the surface where the playing field is located and the space allocated to the zone of substitute players, members of the coaching staff, Match Officials, Officials, photographers, cameramen, members of the radio and television press, and advertising spaces.

(ii) play field: the rectangle in which a match is held in accordance with the rules of the game and recognized by FIFA, whose measures are 46 meters in length; 35 meters wide. It is forbidden to alter and / or modify the measures of the court and / or playing field during the course of the corresponding Season or Tournament.

C. COMPETITIONS

ARTICLE 10 The competitions organized by the Federation, through its Professional Divisions or the Amateur Sector, can be: a) Officials and Friendly. b) National, State, and International. Amateurs d) Game system by points or by elimination.

ARTICLE 11 In the point system, these will be awarded as follows: a) 3 points per game won. b) 1 point per game tied. c) 0 points per lost match. d) -1 point per game lost by default.

ARTICLE 12 In case of a tie in points between two or more teams at the end of the regular phase, the tiebreaker system for assigning places in the general table and advancing to playoffs will be determined by the following criteria and in order of importance to) Goal difference b) Goals in favor c) Fewer red cards.

In the "playoff" phase (quarterfinals and semifinals) the criteria in the event of a tie will be the position they occupy in the general tournament table in the regular phase.

In the final match (1st and 2nd place) in case of a draw, there will be no extra time, they will go directly to execute 3 shoot outs each team and only the players who finish the match within the field will be able to throw.

ARTICLE 13 Once the calendars of a competition have been approved, the order of the parties is not susceptible to alteration, except for reasons of circumstances beyond one's control or fortuitous event.

D. ABOUT THE GAMES

ARTICLE 14 In the matches organized, endorsed or authorized by the Federation, the "Fair Play" promulgated by FIFA shall prevail.



ARTICLE 15 The statutory number of players on the pitch is 7 for each team. In no case the minimum number of players to start a match may be less than 5 players, without prejudice to the fact that throughout the entire match they complete the regulation number of 7 players.

ARTICLE 16 At the time set for the start of the match the Referee will give the signal to start the match, there will be only an extension for the case of the 7:45 p.m. game and it will be 10 minutes.

ARTICLE 17 Once the match has started, if one of the contestants has a number of less than five players for expulsion, the Referee will decide the suspension of the game and will settle this circumstance in his Arbitration Report, taking it to the corresponding Commission of Honor and Justice to that the resolution that is appropriate be taken.

ARTICLE 18 In the official matches, the Technical Directors may substitute without limitation the players, either due to injury or tactical or technical reasons. To make substitutions, you must wait until the game is momentarily suspended and ask the Referee for the corresponding permission. In any case a player substituted can return to the field of play.

E. PLAYERS LINE-UP

ARTICLE 19 Before starting the game, the teams must be registered in the printed card that will have the referee in their custody with their respective official records, which will be known as the players' line-up and each game will have to present their official identification with photography and The league will take the photo of the identification and photo of the player to make the card or credential of the team.

ARTICLE 20 For the purposes of this article, the list of players registered on the website and appear on the game card (starters and substitutes) even if they do not participate in the corresponding match. In order for the players of a team to qualify validly in official matches, the following is required:

- a) That they have been registered on the website of SPORTI on the date indicated by the league, and that it is in possession of an official record of the same.
- b) That meets the requirements of the tournament or specific format to which they belong.
- C) That within the same competition the player has not aligned with different equipment.

ARTICLE 21 For the effects of alignment of players, in the cases in which they are established, only registered players in the competition will be aligned before performing the penultimate day of the regular season.



F. MATCH BALLS

ARTICLE 22 The balls that are used in official matches must be number 5. Each team must bring a ball to start the game, otherwise they may lose the game by default.

G. EQUIPMENT

ARTICLE 23 Players must wear the registered game uniforms set at the SPORTI webpage, prior to the start of the Season, and duly equipped in accordance with the provisions of the of the game rules. The mandatory basic uniform of a Player shall be:

1. Full Uniform (shirt with number, shorts, socks, shin guards and turf shoes or cleats). In case of using thermal trousers or T-shirts, these must have the same color as the short or sleeve. In the case of the thermal shirt it may be of another color, as long as it is not confused with the uniform color of the opposing Team.
2. Goalkeeper: each goalkeeper will wear colors that differentiate him from other players, from the Referee.
3. Players are prohibited from using bands, caps, wristbands, trousers and / or thermal t-shirts with commercial advertising not authorized by the SPORTI Organizing Committee. It is forbidden to play with mechanical kneepads or implements that could hurt opposing players or their own team.
4. Security: Players will not use or carry any object that is dangerous to themselves or to the other Players.

Under no circumstance will the participation of players who wear SPIKES be accepted, only turf shoes or cleats may be played.

The referees are entitled to remove players who do not comply with this provision from the field of play.

H. WITHDRAWALS

ARTICLE 24 The team that once started a competition withdraws from it will lose the right to participate in any other event of the Season; in the case of the League Championship it will automatically descend to the Division or lower Category.

I. GAME SUSPENSIONS

ARTICLE 25 The parties of official competition may only be suspended for the following reasons, in the opinion of the Arbitrator and / or Organizing Committee of SPORTI: a) Causes of force majeure or fortuitous event. b) Poor condition of the playing field. c) By invasion of the public appreciating the circumstances according to their good judgment, reaching the suspension only that this is inevitable. d) Due to incompetence of one of the contestants. e) Lack of electric power (due to reasons beyond SPORTI) f) Environmental conditions g) Due to the numerical inferiority of a team, at the start or during the development of the match. In no case may the expelled players join the team in the continuation of a suspended game, but players who, at the



time of the suspension, are out of the game due to injury, may subsequently join the team.

J. REFEREES

ARTICLE 26 The Referee is the athletic authority to direct the friendly matches or authorized officials.

ARTICLE 27 The authority of the Referee begins at the moment of entering the field or sports venue where the match is played and does not end until he leaves.

ARTICLE 28 The Managers, the coaching staff and Players must abide by the decisions of the referees and lend them all their support and protection to guarantee the independence of their actions and the respect of their investiture.

ARTICLE 29 The Referee shall prepare the Arbitration Report of the match in which he shall record: a) players lineup. b) coaching staff. c) booking (yellow card) and send a player off (red card). d) Incidences of the game. e) Referee Report that must be signed by the team captains, being responsible for the authenticity of the relationship of the members of the coaching staff and Players participating in the match.

ARTICLE 30 The referees may extend the report of the events or circumstances of the party already established in the report, said report shall be notified to the Organizing Committee of SPORTI.

The extension must refer to the facts stated in the match referee report, or subsequent events related to the same game.

The captains of the contending Clubs may request the Referee to add in the Report the protests or facts related to the match, provided they do so in writing (mail or formal letter), within 24 hours after the end of the match.

K. SANCTIONS FOR CARDS AND FAULTS

ARTICLE 31 The equivalence of the cards will be as follows: **Yellow Card will have to leave the field of play for a period of 2 minutes and may re-enter or substitute another player and will be applied at the discretion of the referee in the following cases:**

- Faults
- Provocations.
- Frequent complaints to the referee, to rival players or players of the same team.
- Cut plays with hand or fouls on a recurring basis.
- Make time deliberately.
- Do not wear a full uniform player and enter the court during the game.



- Choose a free kick quickly without authorization from the referee (madruguete). TWO YELLOW CARDS ARE EQUIVALENT TO A BLUE CARD.
- BLUE CARD is an expulsion in the current game and the player can not be substituted by another player.
- Intentional recurring fouls.
- Reoccurrence in complaints and angry discredit to the referee, teammates or rival team, among others.
- Denying and obvious Goal Scoring Opportunity: commit a foul or hand in obvious play of goal being clearly the rival player the last man.

RED CARD EXPULSION IN THE GAME IN PROGRESS WHERE THE PLAYER CAN NOT BE REPLACED, PLUS DISABILITY OF ONE OR MORE SUBSEQUENT GAMES (ROUNDS) of suspension:

- Severe rough game: Intent to hurt, kick for back or bad intention during a play.

RED CARD THAT THE COMMITTEE TOGETHER WITH THE LEAGUE WILL DETERMINE THE SUSPENSION (rounds):

- Insults and Denigration to: Organizing Committee, Team and Players, Team and Opponent Players, Referee, Scorekeepers or Medical Service.
- Incitation: To fight, mockery, conatus of anger.
- PROVOCATION TO violence in any of its forms, physical, verbal, etc.
- Any type of racial or social discrimination.
- Hitting or physical or verbal aggression without the ball in dispute, or in cases where there is a ball in dispute at the discretion of the referee.

IN THE EVENT OF AN RE-INCIDENCE TO A RED CARD THAT HAS BEEN SANCTIONED BY THE COMMITTEE AND THE LEAGUE, IT WILL CAUSE PLAYER DISABILITY IN AN INDEFINITE WAY UNTIL THE COMMITTEE AND THE LEAGUE DETERMINE THE FINAL SANCTION.

WHEN A REFEREE ANTICIPATED THE FINAL WHISTLE ENDING THE MATCH FOR A SITUATION OF INSECURITY AND FOR THE IMPOSSIBILITY OF CONTROLLING SITUATION AMONG THE TEAMS INVOLVED IN THE MATCH, BETWEEN SEVERAL PLAYERS OF BOTH TEAMS AND / OR INVASION TO THE COURT OF PLAYERS WHO SHOULD HAVE BEEN IN THE SUBSTITUTES BENCH AND / OR INVASION OF PERSONS OTHER THAN THE GAME THAT MUST BE OUT OF THE COURT, THE CORRESPONDING SANCTION WILL BE: TEAM OR TEAMS DISABLED (INCLUDING THE PLAYERS INVOLVED) TO PARTICIPATE AGAIN IN ANY TOURNAMENT ORGANIZED BY SPORTI. CONTAINMENT OR INCIDENCE OF FELT BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER THE GAME, BE IT THE INVOLVED PLAYERS, COACHES,



TECHNICAL BODY OR OTHER PERSONS, FAMILY AND / OR PARTY ACCOMPANYING THE TEAM INVOLVED WITHIN THE SPORTI FACILITIES WILL BE DEFINITELY SUSPENDED FROM THE CURRENT EVENT AND ANY OTHER TOURNAMENT ORGANIZED BY SPORTI.

ARTICLE 32 Coaches or assistants who are not active players: The teams that have a coach or assistant must be registered on the website through a letter of authorization from captain and sub captain with the objective of regulating their active participation during matches and in case of faults to the regulation they will be sanctioned by the following assumptions:

- Strong language to: COMMITTEE, OWN TEAM, OPPOSING TEAM and REFEREE
- Incitement: To fight, mockery, conatus of anger and violence in any of its forms, physical, verbal, etc.
- Denigrate to the authority: to the referee, COMMITTEE
- Discrimination of race and / or social gender:
- Dis accreditation of authority
- Ironic claims
- Recidivism in claims.

L. FOULS AND SHOOT OUT

ARTICLE 33 The accumulation of fouls will be sanctioned by a Shoot Out:

- The accumulation of 6 fouls of a team will be sanctioned by a shootout.
- The consecutive accumulation of 3 additional fouls after the first 6 fouls will be punished with another shoot out (9, 12 or 15).
- The shootout will be charged for the mark established on the pitch (approximately 15 steps), all players will be in the middle of the field except for the shooter and the goalkeeper, at the whistle of the referee the game will be resumed.
- The penalty kick is not counted as a cumulative foul for the shootout.
- In the final-final, the shoot-out will enter as a tie-breaking criterion.
- In the shootout the shooter will have 6 seconds to make his final shot in the event of a tiebreak in the final match.
- In the final-final The shoot-out shoot will be 3 per team, in case of remaining tied they will go to sudden death.
- The players eligible to shoot the shoot outs will be those who finish the game.

M. FREE KICKS

ARTICLE 34 The free throws will be sanctioned in the following way:

- Direct: The player may shoot directly to the goal with the authorization of the referee.
- Indirect: To put the ball in motion, the ball must be touched by at least 2 people.
- The distance of the ball to the barrier that the referee must mark must be 7 meters.



- The free throw will always be charged until the referee indicates it, "madruguete" can not be applied and in case of doing so the player will be booked.

ARTÍCULO 1 En los partidos de las competencias de carácter oficial o amistoso de las Divisiones Profesionales se autorizará el ingreso a la cancha solo a: Jugadores y Suplentes uniformados que participarán en cada partido, Árbitros, integrantes del Cuerpo Técnico, personal de Sporti Desarrollo Deportivo, Responsable de las Fuerzas de Seguridad Pública y Seguridad Privada y Policías encargados de cuidar el orden.

PERSONNEL AUTHORIZED TO ENTER AND / OR STAY IN THE FIELDS DURING THE CELEBRATION OF GAMES.

ARTICLE 1 In the matches of the official or friendly competitions of the Professional Divisions the entrance to the court will be authorized only to: Players and uniformed substitutes that will participate in each match, Referees, members of the coaching staff, SPORTI staff, Responsible for the Public Security and Private Security Forces and Police responsible for taking care of order. Staff assigned as Medical Service, photographers, cameramen and TV and radio announcers, duly accredited.

ARTICLE 2 Any person not authorized to remain on the court will be removed by the Referee. In case of not complying with the instruction, the Security Coordinator will be informed so that the offender is removed by the public force through him. The authorized reporters to enter the field can only perform activities of their profession such as interviews and video shots, so they are strictly prohibited from interfering in the game, and therefore can not address the players, members of the coaching staff and / or referees, in order to refer them to plays or actions during the development of the match. All cameramen and assistants must wear a vest that identifies them.

ARTICLE 3 The location of the photographers, cameramen, reporters and commentators, prior to the start of the match, will be aligned with the flag of the center of the field for photographers and cameramen to take the necessary photos and shots, taking their positions after headers before whistle start of the match.
